

1 Introduction

1.1 Overview

At borwell, we are committed to ensuring that modern day slavery, human trafficking or any similar human rights abuse is not taking place anywhere within our supply chain or any part of borwell. We will ensure these aims are achieved by identifying and mitigating the risk in the following ways:

- The company will not knowingly support any business involved with slavery and/or human trafficking;
- Audit and review the practices to ensure all employees have the right to work within the UK;

1.2 Suppliers

At borwell we maintain a list of all our suppliers and ensure that all of these are adequately vetted with references to ensure that they comply with the Modern Slavery Act 2015. As part of a contractual agreement with our suppliers, we also ensure, specifically in relation to the Modern Slavery Act 2015, that:

- Where our supplier is based in the UK, we ensure that they pay their employees at least the National Minimum Wage or National Living Wage;
- Where our supplier is based outside of the UK, we ensure that they pay their legal corresponding minimum wage;
- We are to terminate our contract if we suspect that our supplier is breaching the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

1.3 Further steps

We will work closely with our supply chain to highlight any areas of risk and to reinforce and educate employees within the business. borwell have not identified any significant risks of modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chain. However, we will continue to review and be proactive in our measures against slavery and human trafficking.

1.4 Approval of this statement

The modern-day slavery policy has been approved at Board level who will review and update it as required.

1.5 Point of Contact
